In 2020, the State of Connecticut began the process of dissolving its county government system to create a regional system which better reflects the social-economic relationships within the state.

In 2022, nine planning regions were approved by the Federal government as "county equivalents" and are now used for statistical purposes.

The Office of Management and Budget determined the Metropolitan and Micropolitan areas by the nine planning regions.
